See you at the CLUB.

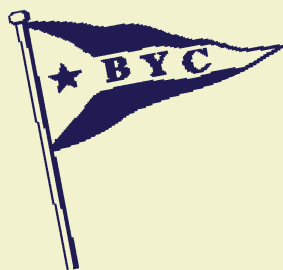


Juniors Looking to 2010

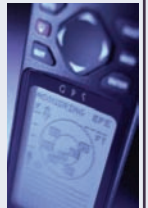

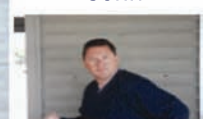

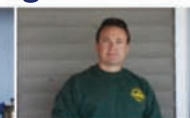
