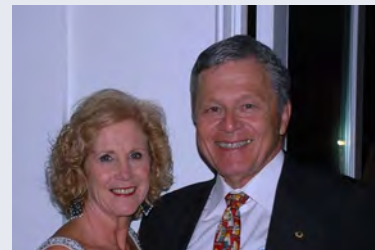

The Pool is Open

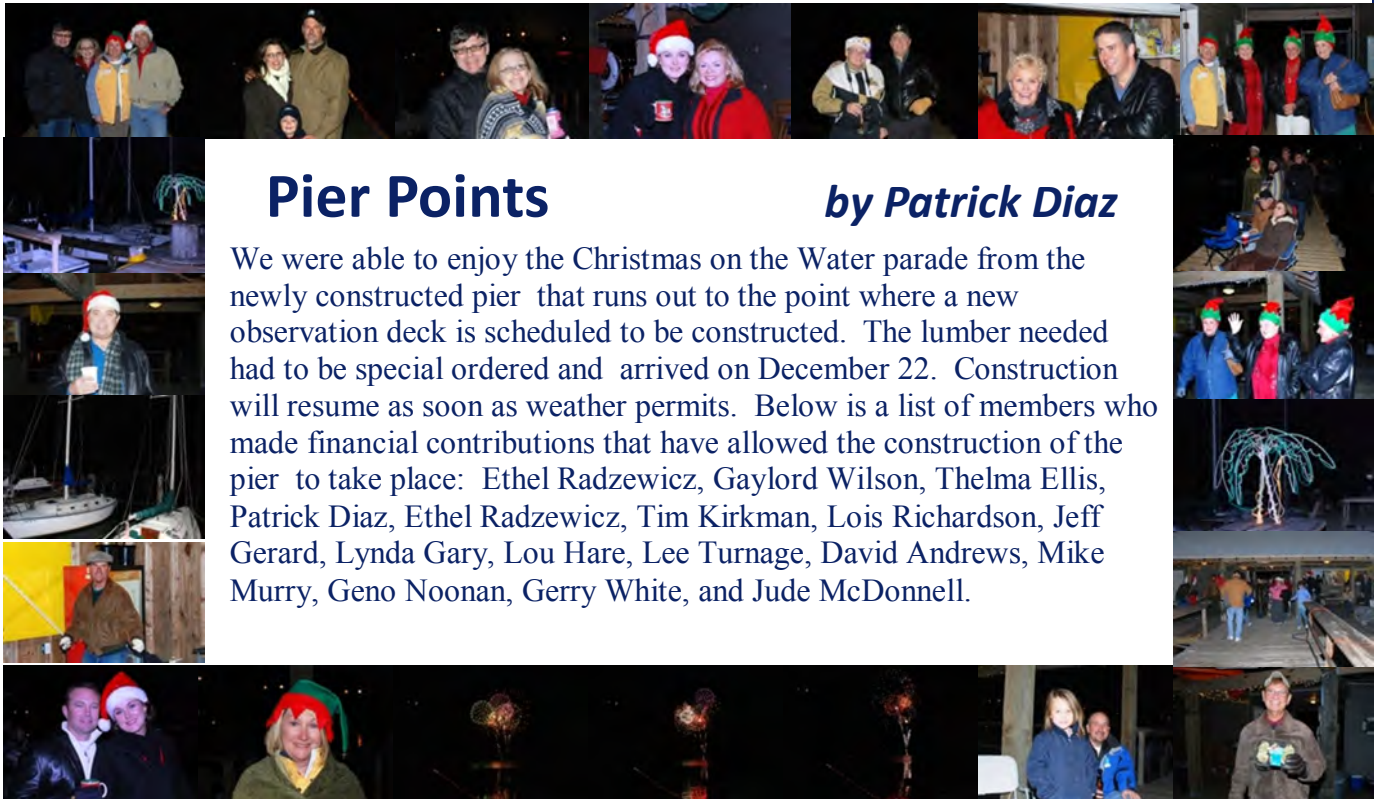
