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From the Commodore

We have completed the 1st month of 2007 and the year is off to a roaring start. Your Board & Flag Officers have been busy getting the New Year started. The Board has held its first official meeting and have approved the nominations of appointed Flag Officers, Committee Chairs, sadly accepted the resignation of one Board Member (Thanks to Roger Milford for two years of dedicated service) and enthusiastically accepted the appointment of a new Board Member (a special welcome to Wendell Lee and many thanks for serving the remainder of Roger's term) and trudged their way through a multitude of items needed to keep the club running smoothly. A proposed budget was presented for review and comments and should be approved at the February Board meeting.

Thanks to the hard work of Rear Commodore Gaylord Wilson the club has received a grant from the Mississippi Gulf Coast National Heritage Commission for \$10,000 to be used in the rebuilding of our facilities. Gaylord will be working with the Commission on other grants that we maybe eligible for.

Another special thank you goes to Rosalie Manual. Rosalie has donated two sunfish boats along with a double decked trailer to the club's Junior Sailing program. All of us cannot say thank you enough to Rosalie and Larry for all of the support that they have given the club. The sunfish is a great boat for progression of our juniors from the Optimist till they are ready for the Flying Scots.


We have also received word from the President of the US Sunfish Class Association that the BYC has been selected to receive three completely refurbished Sunfish from the Austin Yacht Club for use with our Junior Program. The boats have been completely refurbished by the official measurer of the USSCA and I will be asking for help soon to go to Baton Rouge to pick the boats up.

Update on club activities:

- Club Property - At a Special General Membership Meeting held on the 14th of January the membership approved the to accept an offer from a group of investors to exchange a portion of our property for a parcel located approximately 110' to the east. There are drawings in the club that show exactly what portions are being exchanged and I recommend that each of you come in to see exactly what is going to happen. Remember that the terms of this contract are to be treated as "CONFIDENTIAL" and are not to be discussed with anyone outside our Club family.
- Club Building - A New Club Building Committee has been formed to start the ball rolling on the building of a new club house. The committee consists of Buzzy Bolton, Mitch Parker, Wendell Lee, and your commodore. As we progress towards obtaining a design, starting and completion of construction and commissioning of the new club house the committee will of course change in numbers and expertise to meet the needs of the committee at that time. As part of the exchange of property the committee has started the paper work required for the re-zoning of the new lots and preliminary layouts for the membership to comment on.
- Committees
- House - Chair Mitch Parker has dived into getting the club & kitchen running smoothly with this commodore's special thanks.
- New Kitchen Equipment - Mitch has quickly realized that Chef Matt has done wonders getting the food service up and running and that he has outgrown the existing kitchen facilities. Chef Matt is serving 10-20 lunches daily and over 35 dinners on Friday nights. He is also serving dinner on Wednesday nights with the 2nd Wednesday of the month being a Liver & Onion special. Mitch has asked for, and the Board has approved monies to turn the north-west corner room of the new trailer into a new galley kitchen for Matt. Mitch is making sure that all of the equipment being purchased will be usable in the new club house when it is completed.
- Wireless Internet Service - You can now come bring your e-mail and web surfing to the club. Thanks to our computer guru and website designer Robbie Schmidt for installing a wireless internet system for our members use. Your BYC Clubhouse is now an internet café for your entire web surfing needs. (This article is being typed at the bar while being connected to the internet.)


